COLLEGE PROFILE

Fatima College (Autonomous), Mary Land, Madurai, is a Postgraduate College for women affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University. It is a Catholic minority institution established and run by the St. Joseph's Society of Madurai (of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Lyon, France). The institution came into existence through the tireless efforts of the missionary sisters of St. Joseph of Lyon and the zeal and heroic sacrifices of Rev. Sr. Rose Benedicta, the Foundress of the College.

The College was started as a Second Grade College with 63 students in 1953 on the Campus of St. Joseph's School, Madurai. It was upgraded into a Postgraduate College in 1964 and was conferred with Autonomy Status in 1990. The College offers 22 Undergraduate Programmes, 15 Postgraduate Programmes and 3 Professional Programmes (UG-1; PG-2). 8 Departments have become Research Centres. It has a strength of 3875 students, 210 Teaching Staff and 90 Non-Teaching Staff.

The comprehensive assessment by NAAC in 1999 bestowed upon Fatima College the Five Star Status of merit. The College strives to sustain excellence and quality while moulding the students to meet the demands of higher education in India. In 2004, the UGC conferred on Fatima College the status of College with Potential for Excellence. In 2006 and 2013, the NAAC re-accredited the College with 'A' Grade. In 2021-2022, the NAAC re-accredited the College with the highest grade of 'A++'. Fatima College secured 100th Rank in the NIRF 2025 conducted by the Ministry of Human Resource Development in All India "College" category.

A Bachelor's degree in any discipline with an aggregate of minimum 50% marks. Candidates can apply with the Mark Statements of Semester V/VII.

MCA

Applicants must qualify in any one of the approved Common Entrance Tests like MAT, TANCET and Consortium. Meritorious candidates will be called for a Group Discussion and an Interview.

Eligibility

A Bachelor's degree in any discipline with an aggregate minimum 50% marks. Students should have studied Mathematics at +2 / Degree Level. Candidates can apply with the Mark Statements of Semester V/VII.
